

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AND PETILLO INCORPORATED
FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT FOR BASEBALL FIELDS 1, 2 & 3
LOCATED AT TURKEY BROOK PARK**

WHEREAS, there is located in the Township of Mount Olive, three baseball fields located at Turkey Brook Park and commonly referred to as baseballs fields 1, 2 & 3 (hereinafter referred to as the “Fields”); and

WHEREAS, the MOT and the Mount Olive Baseball Softball Association (hereinafter referred to as the “MOBSA”) have determined that the Fields are in need of drainage improvements so that the Fields may be in optimal condition for play for the youth participants of the MOBSA; and

WHEREAS, Petillo Incorporated (hereinafter referred to as “PETILLO” has agreed to perform the work for the drainage improvements for the fields; and

WHEREAS, PETILLO, the MOT and the MOBSA have agreed to a scope of work and general conditions for the work as provided for the plans and specifications for the project and a Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, the MOT, MOBSA and PETILLO have concluded that the proposed drainage improvements will promote the use of funded parkland for recreation and conservation purposes, is in the best interests of the MOT, the MOBSA , the citizens of MOT, and members of the public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mount Olive Township Council, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Township and Petillo Incorporated, attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof, for drainage improvements of baseball fields 1, 2 and 3 at Turkey Brook Park.
2. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and Township Clerk of Mount Olive Township to execute, on behalf of the Township, the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Township and Petillo Incorporated.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
