WHEREAS, the Township has received bids on February 24, 2015 for Bid# 03-2015 to wit; Stabilization of Seward Mansion Historic Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Township duly advertised for bids and bids were opened on February 24, 2015 where all bids were received were in excess of the estimated grant and budget figures as prepared by Connolly & Hickey Historical Architects; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Publics Contract Law, 40A:11-1 et seq., allows for rejection of bids in such circumstances where bids are in excess of budget estimates (40A:11-3.2(a)).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, that the recommendation is hereby accepted, all bids for the Stabilization of Seward Mansion Historic Grant bids are hereby rejected, and the Qualified Purchasing Agent is authorized to immediately seek rebid in consultation with the historical architects of record.
