



Do You Know If Your Drinking Water Is Safe?

RHA, in partnership with municipal Environmental Commissions, is providing affordable well water testing for residents **April 1st through June 15th**. In New Jersey, private wells are not tested by any federal, state, or local authority. The CDC, EPA, and local health departments all **recommend well water be tested annually**. They won't do it, so it's up to you!






Summer Nature Day Camp Registration Open
