

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN BUSINESS WATCH INTERNATIONAL (USA) INC. AND THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, as part of the provision of law enforcement services, the Mount Olive Township Police Department (“MOTPD”) receives, reviews, and maintains a record of reports received from pawnbrokers, secondhand metal recyclers, and secondhand stores in Mount Olive Township; and

WHEREAS, Business Watch International (USA), Inc. (“BWI”) has developed an internet based service, called the BWI Regional Automated Property Information Database (“RAPID”) system, that enables the electronic transmission, between the companies and MOTPD, of information regarding the purchase or pawn from the public of second hand goods; and

WHEREAS, the MOTPD and BWI wish to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”) which memorializes the services to be provided by BWI.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, authorizes the Mount Olive Township Police Department to execute the MOA between the MOTPD and BWI for the provision and service related to the RAPID system as set forth in the MOA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Police Chief of the Mount Olive Township Police Department is authorized to execute the Memorandum of Agreement attached hereto.
