

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT TO JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT FOR RELOCATION OF UTILITY POLES AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW UTILITY STUB POLE

WHEREAS, currently Jersey Central Power & Light (“JCP&L”) has two (2) utility poles located on a parcel of property, identified as Block 6000, portion of Lot 11 (“Property”), in the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris which Property is owned and administered by the Township; and

WHEREAS, improvements are being performed on the Property located at the Pleasant Hill Road and Flanders-Bartley Road intersection; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the improvements, JCP&L must relocate certain poles and install a new stub pole and guy wire; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council have reviewed, are familiar with and have agreed to the terms and conditions of the Right-of-Way Easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Right-of-Way Easement.
