

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE ADDITIONAL SERVICES OF IPAY AND IREPORTING FROM ADP AND MANDATING DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR ALL EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, Governor Christie signed a bill into law (PL 2013, c28) mandating that state employees be required to have direct deposit of their paycheck and this began as of July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, municipalities may also opt for mandatory direct deposit for their employees in an effort to maintain cost savings; and

WHEREAS, the Township believes that moving to a paperless payroll system will provide for cost savings as well as record storage reduction and will allow greater flexibility for employees to gain access to their paychecks and W-2's.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that the Finance and/or Administration is authorized to implement iPay and IReporting through ADP and will mandate direct deposit for all employees.
