

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF CERTAIN
FUNDS FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S TREE BANK FUND FOR THE
BEAUTIFICATION OF MUNICIPAL PARKS, ALL VETERANS MEMORIAL
AND OTHER MUNICIPAL SITES**

WHEREAS, the Township adopted Ordinance# 12-2001 to protect trees; requiring the re-planting of same and establishing a Tree Fund; and

WHEREAS, Jim Lynch, Supervisor of Parks, Buildings & Grounds has requested and expenditure not to exceed \$12,000 from the Township's Tree Bank Fund for the beautification of Municipal Parks, All Veterans Memorial and other municipal sites; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has recommended the expenditure of certain funds, deposited already in the Township's Tree Bank Fund for the purposes described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to endorse this project subject to the issuance of a certification of available funds from the CFO.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, that it does hereby authorize the expenditure of up to \$12,000, utilizing Herold's Landscaping as the vendor to provide trees for the beautification of Municipal Parks, All Veterans Memorial and other municipal sites subject to the issuance of the certificate of available funds from the CFO.
