

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF  
CONCESSIONS FOR FARMING SERVICES OF PUBLIC PROPERTIES  
BLOCK 600 LOTS 5 & 6, FORMERLY KNOWN AS MARVELAND  
FARMS**

**WHEREAS**, the Township has a need to maintain farming and beautify various public properties within the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, such services are currently available to be provided through the concession process under the New Jersey Local Publics Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. Seq., and

**WHEREAS**, the Township owns available property to be farmed at Block 600, lots 5&6 on the tax maps of the Township of Mount Olive, formerly known as “Marveland Farms”; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township will provide for approximately 10 acres be available for farming under a contract with the successful respondent to a competitive contract/ concession RFP; ,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Township’s Business Administrator is hereby authorized to commence the competitive contract/concession procurement process as permitted under the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law allowing for a minimum of 20 days’ notice after resolution authorizing same.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
