

Dear Assemblyman Bucco,

We are writing to you today to express concern with A326 and A1475, currently working their way through the legislative process. Both of these bills would have a significant negative impact on PILOT programs now under consideration in Netcong and redevelopment in the Borough and throughout the state.

If either of these bills are adopted into law the amount of PILOT funds available to a municipality would be greatly reduced. As a result PILOT programs would become a less attractive to municipalities and less likely available as an incentive to developers.

Financial incentives, such as PILOTs are essential. Prior to engaging in any project, a redeveloper must review all of anticipated costs for the scope of the project, including future taxes. Many of these costs are uncertain and such uncertainty may scare potential developers away.

The Borough has three redevelopment projects under consideration and at various levels of approval. All three projects will transform underutilized industrial properties into vibrant components of the Netcong community. They are being planned with the intent of minimal impact on our schools and will require little to no county services. By reducing the financial incentives for both

the municipality and the redeveloper, as these bills will do, the odds of a successful project are greatly diminished.
