

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF THE FLANDERS FIRST AID SQUAD'S
"1996 E-ONE RESCUE TRUCK" TO THE SOMERSET FIRE ACADEMY**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has determined that the Flanders First Aid Squad's "1996 E-One Rescue Truck", while still functional is no longer needed for public purposes due to the acquisition of new rescue truck, and wishes to donate same to the Somerset Fire Academy; and

WHEREAS, the Somerset Fire Academy has agreed to offer training credits to the Township in return for the donation; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(2) provides that such personal property may be sold to another governmental unit or quasi-governmental unit in the United States by private sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Flanders First Aid Squad's "1996 E-One Rescue Truck" is hereby declared to be surplus, no longer needed for public purposes; and
2. It is hereby authorized to donate Flanders First Aid Squad's "1996 E-One Rescue Truck" to the Somerset Fire Academy for their purpose.
