

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
REGULATING THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC INGRESS AND EGRESS RELATING TO A
SERVICE STATION TO BE BUILT AT BLOCK 8301, LOTS 17 AND 18 IN MOUNT OLIVE
TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, in 2015 the Township Planning Board issued land use approvals to Roadranger Holdings, Inc. for construction of a small gasoline service station to be located at the intersection of Sand Shore Road and U.S. Route 46 in Mount Olive Township, Block 8301, Lots 17 and 18; and

WHEREAS, The Township Planning Board's approval was conditioned upon, among other things, Roadranger Holdings, Inc.'s receipt of a permit from the New Jersey Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Roadranger Holdings, Inc. applied for said permit and, by letter dated November 23, 2015, was advised of certain conditions the New Jersey Department of Transportation required be met prior to issuance of the requested permit; and

WHEREAS, among these conditions were requirements for the Township to adopt a Resolution regulating the flow of traffic ingress and egress at the service station location; and

WHEREAS, the Township Planning Board and Rangerover Holdings, Inc. have agreed that the regulation of said traffic flow is necessary to the safe operation of the proposed service station and have agreed to such measures; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Township to adopt Resolutions regulating the traffic flow around the service station.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Trucks over four (4) tons will be excluded from entering the proposed service station located at the corner of Sand Shore Road and U.S. Route 46 through the Route 46 Westbound driveway. Said Route 46 Westbound driveway shall bear a sign indicating "TRUCKS OVER 4 TONS EXCLUDED".
2. All vehicles will be excluded from exiting the proposed service station located at the corner of Sand Shore Road and U.S. Route 46 onto Route 46 Westbound. Said Route 46 Westbound exit shall bear a sign indicating "DO NOT ENTER".
