Poles and Posters Don't Mix

If you are planning to use a sign to publicize any activity, please post it on a stake, not on a utility pole. **Nails, staples or other fasteners used to attach signs to poles can be hazardous to our workers who must climb these poles to repair or maintain our equipment.**

In addition, **state law prohibits the posting of signs or outdoor advertising on any utility poles.**

If you want to advertise your event, get permission from property owners to post your signs on stakes, and check with your local municipality on any regulations your town may have about posting signs.
