

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF
MOUNT OLIVE TELEVISION ("MOTV")**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive in the past received a grant from Cablevision as a stipulation for granting a franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive provided a stipend to the Mount Olive Township Board of Education to purchase necessary equipment for the operation of Mount Olive Television ("MOTV"); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive attempted to establish a very detailed framework and committee for the administration of MOTV through Chapter 15 of the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive repealed Chapter 15 of the Township Code, entitled "Educational and Governmental Television Station Policies and Procedures," in its entirety, in part due to a lack of participation by the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has decided that presently the best way to administer MOTV, unless and until a different framework is adopted by the Township in the future, is for the Township to designate one member of the Township Council to oversee the submission of materials for airing on MOTV and make decisions as to content of materials to be aired on MOTV with the assistance of the Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the community's participation in MOTV, and submission of materials for airing on MOTV, will be through a designated member of the Township Council with the assistance and coordination of designated member of the Administration.
