Stream daylighting is one of a suite of "green infrastructure" techniques that are being used to improve stormwater, manage combined sewer systems to reduce overflows (CSOs), and enhance communities. Stream daylighting can help to relieve flooding, improve water quality and create healthy habitats. Daylighting brings buried or piped streams back to the surface and gives them new life.

This workshop will present case studies of two NJ daylighting projects -- a multi-objective project completed on a brownfield site in 2011, and a project currently beginning on the Assunpink Creek in downtown Trenton.

Learn how to apply green stormwater infrastructure in urban areas and incorporate these techniques into the management of combined sewer systems that now present a major pollution problem in many New Jersey communities.


