

CHRISTIE ADMINISTRATION TO PRESENT HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARDS

TRENTON—On Thursday, May 12 from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m., the Department of Environmental Protection’s Historic Preservation Office and the State Historic Sites Council will present the 26th Annual New Jersey Historic Preservation Awards in celebration of Historic Preservation Month.

The ceremony will be at the Morristown National Historical Park. The George Washington Headquarters park museum will open at 2 p.m. for self-guided tours preceding the ceremony.



This year’s awards include the restoration of a Revolutionary War-era mansion used as a headquarters by George Washington; repurposing of two early 20th century Art Deco buildings in Jersey City into residential housing; the historic restoration plan for the Clara Barton Museum in Washington, D.C. rooming



house used by American Red Cross founder Clara Barton; expansion of the boundaries of the Waterloo Village Historic District in Warren County; an educational archaeology program in Mercer County; and a new book on New Jersey citizens and their experiences during the Revolutionary War.

Driving Directions:

Traveling southbound on Interstate 287

- Take Exit 36
- On the exit ramp take the fork for Morris Avenue/ Lafayette, which is the left exit lane

- After you get off the exit ramp you need to immediately get over to the far left lane to turn left at the light onto Ridgedale Avenue
- Left at the next light onto Morris Avenue (Route 510 East)
- Stay going straight on Morris Avenue, Go over 287
- Continue on the left, make the left fork, and follow the signs for Washington's Headquarters. (You've just gone around in a big circle because of all the one-way streets in town.)

Traveling northbound on Interstate 287

- Take exit 36A, Morris Avenue
- At the end of the exit ramp, turn right to be on Morris Avenue (Route 510 east)
- Immediately get over to the left
- Continue on the left, make the left fork, and follow the signs for Washington's Headquarters
