**WHEREAS**, the Township and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection have agreed to enter into a contract, contract number ICU-RW1-16, for the extension of a waterline and service connection for 32 homes/commercial businesses and well sealing for 31 homes/businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the total contract amount, which will be remitted to the Township, is one million thirty-seven thousand one hundred and thirty-nine dollars (\$1,037,139.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council believes it is in the best interest to enter into this contract with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute said Contract.
