

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING INC. UNDER THE NON-FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PAY-TO-PLAY LAW FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE REHABILITATION OF TWO OAKWOOD VILLAGE WATER STORAGE TANKS

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has a need to acquire professional services as a “non-fair and open” contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5 as appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Professional Consulting Inc. has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that they have not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in Mount Olive in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit them from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:11-5 (a)(i) states that, if a municipality utilizes the professional services exemption from the Local Public Contracts Law, “The governing body shall in each instance state supporting reasons for its action in the resolution awarding each contract and shall forthwith cause to be printed once, in the official newspaper, a brief notice stating the nature, duration and service and amount of contract, and that the resolution and contract are on file and available for public inspection the office of the Township Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive authorizes the Mayor to execute a one year contract with Professional Consulting Inc. for engineering services in connection with the rehabilitation of two Oakwood Village water tanks for a contract amount not to exceed \$71,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value to be placed on file with this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will be published in the Township’s legal newspaper.
