

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR STABILIZATION
OF THE SEWARD HOUSE TO BUILDING RESTORATION CONTRACTORS, LLC**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive publicly advertised for bids in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. for stabilization of the Seward House; and,

WHEREAS, on the two (2) publicly advertised bid opening dates, the Township received no proposals from vendors; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council authorized the Business Administrator to engage in negotiations after the two failed bid attempts in accord with the provisions contained within N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the township has successfully received a negotiated proposal in accord with the scope of work as defined within the bid specifications and acceptable within budgetary estimates.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of a Contract to Building Restoration Contractors, LLC for the stabilization of the Seward House in accordance with the bid specifications in the amount of \$107,950.00
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned Contract.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
