

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY
OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE
OF SURETY BOND, CASH BOND AND REMAINING INSPECTION MONIES,
WITH CONDITIONS, FOR THE WORK PERFORMED AT
BLOCK 8500 LOT 19**

WHEREAS, the developer, Kevin Dorlon, has requested a release of the surety bond, cash bond and remaining inspection monies held by the Township of Mount Olive for the work performed in connection with on-site and municipal improvements at Block 8500 Lot 19, VCEA Job #5190.141, in the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the request, performed an inspection of the work previously completed, and recommends by correspondence, dated July 6, 2016, that the surety bond, cash bond and remaining inspection monies posted in connection with this project, which consist of a \$7,131.12 cash bond, a \$64,180.08 surety bond and \$1,985 in remaining inspection monies, be released subject to the conditions noted below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, that it does hereby authorize that the bonds and monies posted in connection with this project, which consist of a \$7,131.12 cash bond, a \$ 64,180.08 surety bond and \$1,985 in remaining inspection monies, be released to the developer subject to the following conditions:

- 1) A two (2) year maintenance bond must be posted by Kevin Dorlon in the amount of \$22,432.00, which represents 15% of the original bond amount, in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Land Use Law; and
- 2) Kevin Dorlon must submit to the Township Engineer as-built plans for the project or an updated survey.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
