

### **DEP TO ANNOUNCE INCREASED MOSQUITO CONTROL EFFORTS AT FISH STOCKING EVENT IN EDISON**

**TRENTON—On Thursday, June 30, at 12 noon**, Department of Environmental Protection officials will join representatives from the New Jersey Department of Health and the Middlesex County Mosquito Extermination Commission to discuss increased efforts to combat mosquitoes statewide.

As part of the announcement, which takes place during National Mosquito Control Awareness Week, reporters are invited to document the DEP stocking a mosquito-breeding pond and marsh area in Edison with mosquito larvae-eating fish raised at the Charles O. Hayford State Hatchery in Hackettstown as part of the agency's wide-ranging bio-control efforts.

The nearest address for location of the fish deployment on Thursday is **150 Meadow Brook Road** in Edison.

#### **Directions:**

From Interstate 287, north and south:

- Take Exit 1A to merge onto US-1 N toward Newark
- Go 1.7 miles to the Parsonage Road exit
- Go 8/10ths of a mile and turn right onto Oakwood Avenue
- Continue 2/10th of a mile onto North Evergreen Road
- Go 3/10th of a mile and turn left onto Meadow Brook Road. Continue to destination
