**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
MOUNT OLIVE CREATING AND CONTINUING THE MOUNT OLIVE  
MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE COMMITTEE**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, State of New Jersey, that in compliance with PL Chapter 51 and the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse, the Committee known as the Mount Olive Municipal Alliance Committee (MOMAC) is hereby re-established. This Committee pledges to work toward the following goals as directed in the Chapter 51 Legislation:

1. Organize and coordinate efforts involving schools, law enforcement, business groups and other community organizations for the purpose of reducing alcoholism and drug abuse.
2. In cooperation with the local school district, comprehensive and effective alcoholism and drug abuse education programs in the grades Kindergarten through 12.
3. In cooperation with the local school district, procedures for the intervention, treatment and discipline of students abusing alcohol or drugs.
4. Comprehensive alcoholism and drug abuse education, support and outreach efforts for parents in the community.
5. Comprehensive alcoholism and drug abuse community awareness programs.
6. The Township Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Mount Olive Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year 2016.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mount Olive Municipal Alliance Committee may include, but not be limited to the following representatives: Mayoral Alliance representative, Chief of Police, President of the School Board, Superintendent of Schools, Student Assistance Coordinator, Representative of the Parent-Teacher Association, Representative of the Local Bargaining Unit for Teachers, Representatives of the Chamber of Commerce, Municipal Court Judge, Representative of Local Civic Associations, Representatives of local religious groups, Private Citizens. A current list of the members of this Committee is attached hereto.
