WHEREAS, Sergeant Eric Anthony serves as the Deputy Office of Emergency Management Assistant Coordinator to the township; instructs Crash Investigation and Emergency Vehicle Operations Training at the Morris County Police Academy for recruits, serves as a Child Safety Seat Technician; and remains a part of Communications and Police Officer selection process and training; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Eric Anthony serves as the fleet purchasing manager and coordinates the up-fitting of all police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Eric Anthony is a Radar Instructor, certified in the LASER to detect speeds, and has extensive training in crash investigation and reconstruction; and is a member of the Morris County Vehicular Homicide Unit; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Anthony participates in the Police Unity Tour where he has pedaled his bicycle 300 miles from New Jersey to Washington D.C. to raise awareness for law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty and the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial (NLEOMF); and

WHEREAS, he has received many awards which include Program Development, Grand Cordon, Honorable Service, Life Saving, Physical Fitness, and Exceptional Duty Awards; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Eric Anthony has successfully passed and met the requirements for recommendation to the rank of Sergeant.
