

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE OF SPACE ON THE TOWNSHIP OWNED WATER TANK FOR WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS LOCATED AT 36 CAMELOT DRIVE, BUDD LAKE, NEW JERSEY TO NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS, LLC (AT&T)

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and received one bid for the Lease of Space on Township Owned Water Tank for Wireless Communications Located at 36 Camelot Drive, Budd Lake, New Jersey from the following vendor:

New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) \$27,000.00 per year

WHEREAS, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) submitted with its bid, certain exceptions to the bid; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council is satisfied with the proposal and all of the exceptions submitted by New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T), the lowest responsible bidder, as being the proposal which satisfies the best interest of the Township and being in conformance with the requirements promulgated pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to proceed with this necessary service and for that purpose accepts the proposal submitted by New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of a contract to New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) for Lease of Space on Township Owned Water Tank for Wireless Communications Located at 36 Camelot Drive, Budd Lake, New Jersey, which Contract shall specify the scope of services as set forth in New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T)'s proposal, at a lease price as set forth in the proposal.
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned contract.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
