**PIVOTAL UTILITY HOLDINGS, INC. D/B/A ELIZABETHTOWN GAS
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

TO OUR CUSTOMERS:

On June 3, 2015, Pivotal Utility Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Elizabethtown Gas (“the Company”) filed a Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“BPU” or “Board”) in BPU Docket No. GR15060656 to increase base distribution revenues by \$1,341,849 or 0.9% from \$148,377,841 to \$149,719,690 to enable the Company to roll in and recover through base rates the costs of the Elizabethtown Natural gas Distribution Utility Reinforcement Effort (“ENDURE”) program. The proposed increase results in a uniform percentage increase in base rate revenues of 1.0% to the service classifications identified below. The Company’s Petition was filed in compliance with a Board Order dated July 23, 2014 in BPU Docket Nos. AX13030197 and GO13090826. Set forth below are the proposed rates, inclusive of taxes and assessments that will permit customers to determine the effect upon them of the proposed increased rates. The actual percentage increase applicable to specific customers will vary according to the usage. Any assistance required by customers in ascertaining the impact of the proposed rate increase will be furnished by the Company upon request.

The combined effect of the Company's filing on the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using an average of 100 therms per month is as follows:

The proposed rates are subject to Board approval and may be higher or lower depending on the Board's final determination and the date on which such rate is made effective. Moreover, any rate relief found by the Board to be just and reasonable may be allocated by the Board and applied by the Company to any class or classes of customers or any rate schedules as the Board may determine, so that final rates approved by the Board in this proceeding for any specific customer class or rate schedule may be higher or lower than those set forth herein.


The BPU has the statutory authority to establish Elizabethtown's rates at levels it finds just and reasonable as well as to establish the effective date of such rates. Therefore, the BPU may establish the rates at levels and/or an effective date other than those proposed by Elizabethtown. Dear Secretary Asbury:

In compliance with the Board of Public Utilities' July 23, 2014 Order in BPU Docket No. AX13030197 and GO13090826, enclosed for filing are an original and ten copies of the Petition of Pivotal Utility Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Elizabethtown Gas ("Elizabethtown" or "Company") requesting authority to roll into and recover through base rates the costs associated with the Elizabethtown Natural gas Distribution Utility Reinforcement Effort Program ("ENDURE"). Attached to and made a part of the Petition are the testimony and supporting schedules of Company witnesses Thomas Kaufmann and Michael P. Scacifero.

Petitioner's ENDURE Program was developed to harden and protect Elizabethtown's infrastructure against damage from future major storm events. These projects are outside the scope of Elizabethtown's normal capital budget.

Elizabethtown is proposing to recover its ENDURE Program costs through an increase in Elizabethtown's base distribution rates of approximately \$1.3 million annually or 0.9%, from approximately \$148.4 million to approximately \$149.7 million effective November 1, 2015 ("ENDURE Revenue Adjustment"). The proposed ENDURE Revenue Adjustment will result in a uniform percentage increase in firm base rate revenues of 1.0% to the Company's RDS, SGS, GDS, LVD, EGF, GLS and FTS service classes, as well as certain firm, Board approved special contract customers served under the terms of Elizabethtown's firm rate classes. The Company's proposed ENDURE Revenue Adjustment will increase the monthly bill of a typical residential

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heating customer using 100 therms by \$0.44 or 0.4% as compared to the Company's currently effective rates.

This Petition presents the request of Pivotal Utility Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Elizabethtown Gas (“Petitioner”) that the Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) accept the filing to revise Petitioner’s base distribution rates to recover the costs of the Elizabethtown Natural gas Distribution Utility Reinforcement Effort (“ENDURE”) Program and certain related tariff revisions. Petitioner is proposing to recover its ENDURE Program costs through an increase in base distribution revenues of approximately \$1.3 million. This is an increase of 0.9% from approximately \$148.4 million to approximately \$149.7 million effective November 1, 2015 (“ENDURE Revenue Adjustment”). The proposed ENDURE Revenue Adjustment will result in a uniform percentage increase in firm base rate revenues of 1.0% to Petitioner’s RDS, SGS, GDS, LVD, EGF, GLS and FTS service classes, as well as certain firm, Board approved special contract customers served under the terms of Petitioner’s firm rate classes. Petitioner’s proposed ENDURE Revenue Adjustment will increase the monthly bill of a typical residential heating customer using 100 therms by \$0.44 or 0.4% as compared to Petitioner’s currently effective rates.
