Kerry Kirk Pflugh

Kerry Kirk Pflugh is a 28-year veteran with NJDEP. She has spent the better part of her career as a liaison to the municipalities and the public on a wide variety of environmental issues

For the past six years, Kerry has served as NJDEP's Manager of Constituent Services. She was the liaison to the Barnegat Bay estuary program and the Lake Hopatcong Commission, responsible for working with counties, municipalities and other stakeholders to ensure their voices are heard by decision makers. Prior to that, Kerry coordinated all the watershed education and communications programs for the Division of Watershed Management. When Kerry first joined NJDEP, she spent 13 years as a Research Scientist in the Division of Science, Research and Technology, working with urban communities on environmental health risks. Kerry also has been a consultant to the federal EPA and Department of Homeland Security on risk communication related to water security.

Kerry earned a Master of Science degree from the University of Wisconsin at Madison in Agricultural Journalism and a Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Communication from Cook College-Rutgers University.
