

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY DOORS & WALKWAYS FOR MT. OLIVE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

**WHEREAS**, the Township has received two (2) bids for the installation of doors and walkways for the Mt. Olive Municipal Building; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest bid received from Mangiro Contracting Co., Inc. was not responsive to the administrative documents that must be submitted at the time of the bid opening therefore causing a mandatory rejection of the bid, and the second lowest bid from M&M Construction Technology was over the budgeted funding for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Qualified Purchasing Agent has reviewed the bid and recommends the bids be rejected as not being legally responsive as defined within the Local Publics Contract Law, N.J.S.A.40A:11-2(27).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that the recommendation is hereby accepted that the bids for Installation of Emergency Doors & Walkways for Mt. Olive Municipal Building are hereby rejected and the Qualified Purchasing Agent is authorized to immediately accept a new round of bids.
