

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF
FINGERPRINT/ PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TECHNOLOGY FOR
MOUNT OLIVE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Township police department has a need to maintain fingerprint/ photographic identification processes for its law enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, such technology has been used in past operations and budgetary approval has been provided to purchase updated technology in the 2015 budget as adopted; and

WHEREAS, there exists efficient purchasing mechanisms through the competitive contract process under the New Jersey Local Publics Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. Seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township police department has expressed a desire to examine and vet out the differing vendor software packages for use in fingerprint/ photo graphic identification technologies; and

WHEREAS, the Township possesses a qualified purchasing agent to lead the project in conjunction with the police department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Township Business Administrator is hereby authorized to commence the competitive contract procurement process as permitted under the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law allowing for a minimum of 20 days notice after resolution authorizing same.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
