

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO ENVIROCON FOR THE GENERATOR FOR THE WATER & SEWER DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mount Olive publicly advertised for bids in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. for a generator for the Water & Sewer Department; and

**WHEREAS**, on the publicly advertised bid opening date, the Township received proposals from the following vendors:

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**WHEREAS**, after review of the bid proposal submissions it has been determined that the bid received from Envirocon, which was a responsive bid and should be accepted.

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council is satisfied with the proposal submitted by Envirocon, the lowest responsible bidder, as being the proposal which satisfies the best interest of the Township and being in conformance with the requirements promulgated pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township wishes to proceed with this necessary service and for that purpose accepts the proposal submitted by Envirocon;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of a Contract to Envirocon for the provision of a generator for the Water & Sewer Department as set forth in Envirocon's proposal, at a total cost not to exceed \$262,682, as set forth in the proposal.
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned Contract.
