The NJDEP Division of Fish and Wildlife will be hosting an absolutely free 2-day Hooked on Fishing-Not on Drugs (HOFNOD) event geared for adults interested in leading or assisting with HOFNOD youth fishing education program. HOFNOD targets teachers, staff and volunteers of schools, and community-/faith-based organizations looking to engage youth in an ongoing or year-round fishing, conservation and aquatic education program.
