









Stream Bacterial Monitoring Underway






Hats off to AT&T!

News from Our Flemington Office


RHA has moved into a larger space at our current location, [124 Main Street in Flemington](#). Now, visitors can get to our office both from the rear parking lot and from the street!


On the Watchdog Front

Did You Know?




Droughts don't happen overnight, and they don't end overnight.

According to the National Weather Service, most of northern New Jersey is several inches below average rainfall this year. That results in less "recharge" of the underground aquifers that supply most of the drinking water to residents of our 470-square-mile
