**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public works was in the need of wastewater membrane modules for the Wyndham Pointe Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were solicited and one (1) sealed bid was received and opened on August 23, 2016, in accordance with the advertised date for acceptance of bids from the following vendor:

**Zenon Environmental Corporation                      \$73,295**

**WHEREAS**, the Qualified Purchasing Agent and Township Attorney find and declare that this one bid was not responsive/responsible due to a material, incurable inclusion of altered terms and conditions and items not called for in the bid proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, specifically N.J.S.A. §40A:11-13.2 authorizes a municipality to reject all bids.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize the rejection of all bids received for the furnishing of wastewater membrane modules be and are hereby rejected for the reasons stated above.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Qualified Purchasing Agent is authorized to send this service out for re-bid.
