

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A TWO (2) YEAR CONTRACT FOR
SNOWPLOWING SERVICES TO SALMON BROS., INC., MD SAVAGE LLC &
NATIVE FIELDS LANDSCAPING**

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and received bids for snowplowing services from the following vendors,

Salmon Bros. Inc. – Route A, B & C

WHEREAS, the Township Council is satisfied with the proposals submitted by Salmon Bros., Inc., MD Savage LLC and Native Fields Landscaping the lowest responsible bidders for their respective snowplowing routes, as being the proposals which satisfy the best interests of the Township and being in conformance with the requirements promulgated pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to proceed with this necessary service and for that purpose accepts the proposals submitted by Salmon Bros., Inc., MD Savage LLC and Native Fields Landscaping;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of contracts to MD Savage LLC, Salmon Bros., Inc., and Native Fields Landscaping for snowplowing services, which contracts shall specify the scope of services as set forth in thier proposals, at total costs and prices not to exceed those set forth in the proposals.
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned contracts.
