TIME, PLACE PRESIDING OFFICER: The Board of Health held their regular meeting on Wednesday April 20, 2011. Mr. Perkins called the meeting to order at 7:33pm. The Pledge to the Flag was recited, Joann Lepre Board Secretary read the “Open Public Meetings Act”.
