

BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MAY 16, 2012

TIME, PLACE PRESIDING OFFICER: The Board of Health held their regular meeting on Wednesday April 16, 2012. Mr. Perkins called the meeting to order at 6:32pm. The Pledge to the Flag was recited, Joann Lepre Board Secretary read the “Open Public Meetings Act”.

Present: Mr. Perkins, Mr. Kana, Mrs. Cooper, Dr. Ross, Dr. Wallack.
Absent: Dr. Abrams, Dr. Miccio

Mr. Perkins recognized the Board Attorney Peter King, Health Officer Frank Wilpert and the Board Secretary Joann Lepre.

MINUTES: Mr. Perkins stated that there was a correction to the minutes. Mr. Perkins asked for a motion to approve the minutes as amended for April 18, 2012. Mrs. Cooper made the motion, seconded by Mr. Kana. All members were in favor. Mrs. Cooper abstained.

CORRESPONDENCE: All correspondence sent with packets.

WRITTEN REPORTS- HEALTH OFFICER, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER AND PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE: Mr. Perkins asked for any comments or comments regard the Health Officers report for April 2012. There were none. Mr. Perkins then asked for a motion to accept the Health Officers report, for April 2012. Dr. Wallack made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Cooper. All members were in favor.

Mr. Perkins asked for any comments or questions regarding Animal Control. Mr. Perkins started a discussion regarding placing garbage curbside, due a bear on his property. A discussion followed, and Mr. Wilpert will follow up with the DPW Director and the Business Administrator on placement of trash (when & how) in order to try and keep the bears away. Mr. Perkins asked for a motion to accept the Health Officers report for April 2012. Mr. Kana made the motion, seconded by Dr. Wallack.

Mr. Perkins asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the Nurses report for April 2012. Dr. Ross asked about the number of unduplicated children seen for the month since it was left blank. Mr. Wilpert stated he would check on it and report back to the Board if it was anything other than zero. Mr. Perkins mentioned this was hepatitis awareness month, and everyone should be aware of hepatitis. Mr. Wilpert asked for information and he would get it put on the webpage.

Mr. Kana asked about TDAP, He stated that many people were ignorant about it. Mr. Wilpert stated that the Nurse has gone from school to school to all the school nurses, and to all the communities we service. A brief discussion followed.

Mr. Perkins asked for a motion to accept the Nurses reports for April 2012. Dr. Ross made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Cooper. All members were in favor.

OTHER REPORTS:

Mr. Perkins asked for any comments or questions regarding apartment inspections, food inspections, court inspections, etc. Mr. Kana stated that it was a long time since there was an unsatisfactory report in any food establishments. Mr. Wilpert stated the inspectors do a good job educating the establishments; he also stated that the food handler’s courses would be starting in June for the upcoming licensing year.
Dr. Ross asked if an inspector could stop and check China Thai in Flanders, due to a coin vending machine That is unsanitary and broken. Mr. Wilpert stated that he would have it inspected.
Mr. Perkins asked for a motion to accept the other reports for April 2012.Mr. Kana made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Cooper. All members were in favor.

ORDINANCE SECOND READING:

Mr. Perkins opened the hearing to the public regarding Ordinance No.: BOH 1-2012 Ordinance of the Mount Olive Board of Health Establishing Section 320 of the Township Code entitled “Massage, Bodywork and Somatic Therapy Establishments”. There was no one from the public. Mr. Perkins closed it to the public. Mrs. Cooper moved the ordinance for final passage, seconded by Dr. Wallack. Mr. Perkins asked for discussions. Dr. Ross asked about a workshop. A discussion followed regarding tabling the final approval. Dr. Ross made a motion to table the ordinance to the next meeting, seconded by Mr. Kana. All members were in favor.Mr. Perkins stated that the board was in workshop to discuss the changes in the ordinance. A discussion followed regarding changes of the phrasing to the ordinance. Dr. Ross made reference to some of the changes he proposed.
Dr. Ross asked for the document to be sent as a word document. Mr. Perkins stated that all members would receive a copy in a word document to review and request changes. Mr. King stated that all changes should be sent to him within the next two weeks, so all members have a chance to review and discuss at the next meeting. It was decided that any changes would be made and sent to Mr. King. Mr. King would get the changes back to Mr. Wilpert, and he would go over them with the Police. All members were in favor.
