Background:

- The Budd Lake Fire Department purchased the ladder in 1980 and the truck was equipped with a 1250 gpm pump and a 350 gallon water tank. Open cab with two pre-connects on it. The truck remained that way until 2002. In 2002, the truck underwent an extensive overhaul by Interstate Truck (Maryland). Listed below are some of the improvements:
 - Cab was enclosed and new doors were made and installed
 - Water tank and the cross lays were removed
 - Rear extended and two compartments one each side were added
 - New breaks and drums as well as a complete undercarriage inspection and motor work
 - Re-painted
 - Compartments re-painted
