- Sports Associations: Mutual Facilities & Sports Associations' meeting is Wed 9/18 at 8am

- Concussion Policy: BOE has issued a policy (and documents) to be implemented for the 2013-14 school year for ALL users of school facilities which includes signing a Hold Harmless statement with concussion policy acknowledgement.
  The BOE policy and forms are posted on our website, the sports groups are required to have their coaches complete a concussion training course, have families sign off on the CDC's family info sheet.
- Sports Ombudsman: Paul Licitra is volunteering to fill this liaison position, and assist the sports associations with meeting best practices as outlined in the National Alliance of Youth Sports Standards
- o Beach Season: Rockefeller Group was our Blue Diamond sponsor (we were able to purchase some replacement sand) and sponsor of the Opening Day BBQ. 15 days were impacted by rain, reducing the 63 day season to 48 full days. Total attendance: 2654. Movie night. Late night swim, concerts and swim lessons were lightly attended. Patrons enjoyed the Regatta and made use of the paddle board instruction provided by Pelican. In 2014 we will include several paddle board workshops and have a 5k paddle on the lake.
