

BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2015

Time, Place Presiding: The Board of Health held their regular meeting on Wednesday, October 21, 2015. Mr. Nicastro called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The Pledge to the Flag was recited. Claudia Tomasello, Board Secretary, read the "Open Public Meetings Act."

Mr. Nicastro recognized the Health Officer, Mr. Trevor Weigle, and the Board Attorney, Peter King. The Board of Health Secretary, Claudia Tomasello, was also recognized.

Minutes: Mr. Nicastro asked for a motion to approve the minutes for September 2015. Dr. Ross made the motion seconded by Dr. Wallack. Mrs. Cooper abstained, all other members were in favor.

Written Reports:

Mr. Nicastro asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the September 2015 Written Reports. Dr. Wallack questioned the ACO Report. The year to date total of cats does not add up to 22. Mr. Weigle will ask Frank Nelson, ACO, for the reasoning behind this. Dr. Wallack also asked about the animal cruelty case that was supposed to go to court on October 8...Mr. Weigle will also look into this. Seeing no more questions or comments Mr. Nicastro asked for a motion to accept the reports. Dr. Wallack made the motion seconded by Mrs. Cooper. All members were in favor.

explained that what is being changed are the decibel levels, they are being made

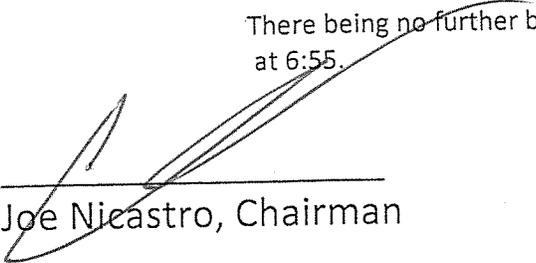

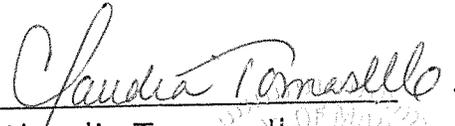
Board Comments: Mr. Kana asked about West Nile Virus and status. Mr. Weigle explained that the

by Dr. Wallack. All members were in favor.

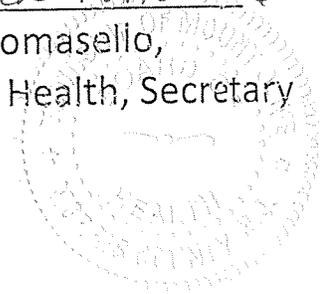

Time, Place Presiding: The Board of Health held their regular meeting on Wednesday, December 16, 2015. Mr. Nicastro called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The Pledge to the Flag was recited. Claudia Tomasello, Board Secretary, read the "Open Public Meetings Act."

New Business: Mount Olive TNR was present to hear the Board's response to the requests made by TNR. One concern was to get access to Eagle Rock Village. Frank Nelson the ACO has been in contact with management there and doing his best to help TNR gain access. TNR had requested to have access to funds for emergency purposes. Michele Lerner was present to explain that TNR would like a line on the animal licenses for residents to make a donation to TNR. Mr. Nicastro explained that the Health Officer, Trevor Weigle, has sat down with the CFO, Sherry Maniscalco, to look into how we can get this set up. As far as the request to try and make licensing more favorable, Mr. Nicastro has agreed to put an article in the paper explaining the benefits to licensing your animal and other important information for the residents. Mr. Nicastro is hoping to get more PR for the licenses. As far as discount booklets being handed out when you license your pet, the Board is in favor of this, however their concern is who organizes this. Michele Lerner also mentioned having discount codes with the license renewal instead of a coupon book. We would be willing to have the census takers hand out fliers to help promote licensing. Michele Lerner continued to give the Board an update on TNR. Mr. Nicastro thanked TNR for the wonderful work and the impressive statistics she provided. Some Board members then questioned why Eagle Rock would not cooperate. Ms. Lerner explained that because residents are not supposed to have animals, she feels the complex is afraid that having a meeting regarding the animals on their site is giving residents permission to have animals. Ms. Lerner feels there are misconceptions and if the owners would just respond they would realize TNR is only looking to help. The Board stated that if there was a health issue we could access the site for this. But, at the moment, there are no complaints to the Health Department and no Health Violations. Catherine Neese, from Aldersgate Circle across the street from the complex, questioned at what

point does the town have access to the complex. Their cats are migrating across the street to the homes there. Peter King, Board Attorney, explained unless there was a health issue, such as rabies, the town can't do anything. This is private property, the town can't force the issue. The residents then need to call and make complaints. Mr. Nicastro explained that if the cats are coming across the street and on your property causing a nuisance the resident needs to call and make a complaint in order for the town to get involved. All the Board members thanked TNR for the commitment and time they have put into this successful program.

Trevor Weigle updated the Board on the Combe Fill North Landfill. Mr. Weigle explained, that as was expected, the level for that compound was drastically reduced, now down from three to .4 parts per billion. There are now more houses affected. Mount Olive Township officials had a meeting on December 15, 2016 with The State Health Department. The State has reached out to all the individuals affected and they will be provided bottled water. The town is talking with the State to extend the water line so the individuals affected will have access to Municipal water. There will be another meeting January 6, 2016. Board members asked about the radius of the area affected. Mr. Weigle explained that this is below International Drive and the State is working on a map for us now. Mr. Kana asked if this water could be filtered and treated to remove the contaminant. Peter King explained that a very big filter system would need to be put in the house and it is very expensive. Mr. Weigle also explained that it does not remove this particular contaminant, which is why a water service is being offered to bring water to the places affected.

Old Business: Dr. Wallack asked about the court appearances for Ace Spa. Mr. Weigle explained that the recent issued summons are in the packet. Dr. Wallack asked about revoking their licenses again. Peter King explained that there is a new owner and we have to build a case again. We are trying to work with them, but if there are continued issues we will take action.

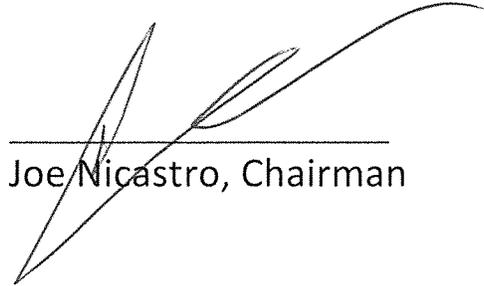

Mr. Weigle explained that she has not worked with us before, and that the Health Educator who worked with us previously has indicated that she has no interest to continue. Mr. Weigle explained that the shared services agreement we had set up with Madison was to utilize Ms. Robinson. However, this agreement was denied by Madison's Council. Instead, we privately contracted with Ms. Robinson. She is part time in Madison and working with us on the other hours. A resume was presented to the Board. Mrs. Cooper asked how many years she has been working. Mr. Weigle explained that she is a fairly new graduate but he has seen her work and is very confident in her abilities. Mr. Weigle explained that he will be receiving monthly reports from Ms. Robinson. All members were in favor.

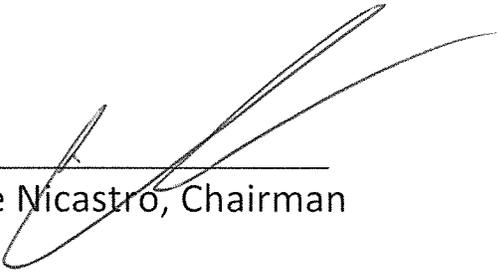

Board Comments: Mrs. Cooper asked about the re-inspection of The Golden Bowl. It was explained that another inspection was done and a Satisfactory was given. The Board wanted to know in more detail exactly what the violations were. Mr. Weigle explained that he had accompanied Derrick Webb, R.E.H.S. on this inspection. It was explained that the major issue was failure to rinse and sanitize. The Golden Bowl was educated on the proper procedures. The Golden Bowl does have a dishwasher. Mr. Kana asked about the violation at Days Inn concerning bed bugs. He asked how we verify the absence or presence of bed bugs in a facility. Mr. Weigle explained that this is mostly a visual discovery on bedding, curtains, and carpet. And, the tell tale signs of the bites. This was one call from one incidence. Mr. Weigle educated the Board on the status of the Zika Virus. We have had conference calls with the State and Mr. Weigle attended a meeting that was presented by the County Health Department and Mosquito Commission. Our new Health Educator will also be working on presenting this to the public. All that is being seen in New Jersey so far is travel transmission. We will be concentrating on educating Dover a little more since they have more families in the South American countries that are on the list.

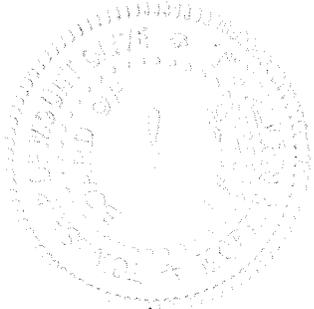
Adjournment:
