**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING
A REVISION TO THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE,
PART 1 ADMINISTRATIVE LEGISLATION CHAPTER 4, ADMINISTRATIVE
CODE ARTICLE XV, BUDGET, PURCHASING AND EXPENDITURES
SECTION 4-73C ENTITLED PROCEDURES FOR PAYMENT**

WHEREAS, the payment procedures for the Township of Mount Olive have been reviewed by the Chief Financial Officer and Director of the Department of Finance and it has been determined that it needed to be updated and or revised; and

WHEREAS, such change will help facilitate the operation of the Township of Mount Olive.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive as follows:

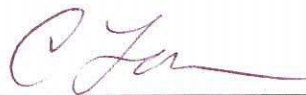
SECTION I. Part 1 Administrative Legislation Chapter 4, Administrative Code Article XV, Budget, Purchasing and Expenditure Section 4-73C **Entitled Procedures for Payment** is hereby amended and supplemented to provide as follows:

§ 4-5. 4-73 Entitled Procedures for Payment.

- C. With the exception of the following specific items, disbursements shall not be made for any voucher in excess of \$2,500.00 on any bill, claim or demand without prior Council approval. The specific exclusion from this approval are as follows:
9. Insurances: Medical/Dental/Prescription/Disability/Life/COBRA/Morris County Joint Insurance Fund.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
